Our goal is to make sure all flooring technicians are receiving the best training in the country to provide the best quality service to clients nationwide. By joining this apprenticeship program, you will learn the skills on how to install flooring, how to deal with customers, and how to manage a crew of installers from the top employers in the nation.

- You will receive top industry certification for floor installation.
- You will earn while you learn, so you will be financially prepared when you complete the program.

- Apprentices that complete the program will have the opportunity to work with national companies.

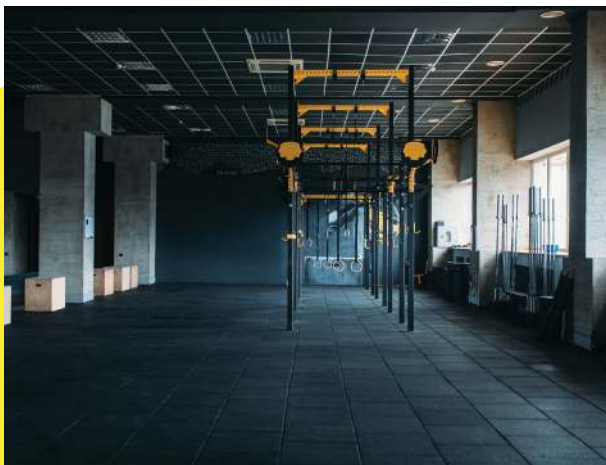
## APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM

The apprenticeship is a 2-4 year hybrid program, so the completion of the program will be based on how many hours you spent training and on your competency of learning installation skills. In other words, the quicker you learn the faster you complete the program to move to the next level. During the program you will take a 5-6 week installation training course to receive your certification, and when you complete the apprenticeship program, you will receive a certificate from the Department of Labor and NFCAP, which will make you automatically a journeyman. When you reach this accomplishment, then you will have the choice to keep working with the current employer or start your own flooring company and become an independent flooring contractor to get contracts from national companies (Home Depot, Lumber Liquidators, Empire Today, etc.).



## TYPES OF FLOORING PROJECTS

In a residential home you will see wood floors, tiles, laminates, luxury vinyl planks, and carpets. In the commercial sector you will encounter flooring installation in an offices, restaurants, hospitals, hotels, and sports arenas. Therefore, in your career path you will have the opportunity to pursue these flooring installation contracts. Below are a few examples of flooring installations:
